2. The event is an open navigation trial held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland, including amendments published, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued before the start of the event

M.I. Permit No: 10/013

3. Save as modified hereunder, the event will be run according to the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland, Appendices 25, 33, 34 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook, these supplementary regulations and any amendments of the standard regulations.
4. Route will be approximately 120 miles in length. Petrol will be required to cover approximately 85 miles without refuelling. Controls and time points will define the route as well as vias which must be visited in the order stated. Grid references will be used to give location of the majority of checks, as well the required approach and departure will be given. Details of up to 4 locations per half will be given during the course of event (i.e. plot and bash / herringbone / tulip and any other method). Additional explanatory diagrams may be given for complicated junction layouts.
5. Ordinance Survey Ireland Discovery Series, Sheet 89, third edition, will be used for the event, plus other methods deemed necessary by the organisers. Competitors are advised that a second copy of sheet 89 may be advantageous. Eric Hopkirk used.
6. Check-in and scrutiny will be from 20.00 hours on Saturday 6th February 2010 at Lissavard Community Hall, Lissavard, Clonakilty, Co. Cork (Grid Reference 335 391). Any crew who have not satisfactorily completed Check-in paperwork by 21:30 hours and/or have not passed Mechanical Scrutiny by 22.00 hours, both on Saturday 6th February will not be allowed start the event. Where prior

notification of a difficulty in complying this requirement is given, and at the sole discretion of the organisers, this rule may be relaxed. The route sheet will be issued no later than 22:00 Competitive Navigation will not begin before 23.30 hours on Saturday 6th February.

7. AWARDS:

- 1st overall, (2 Trophies)
- 1st, 2nd, and, 3rd in class (2 Trophies)
- Best SDCC Crew (2 Trophies)

8. CLASSES: Expert, Semi – Expert, Novice and Beginner

Novice: Any competitor who has not navigated before the 01/09/05 plus any competitor who has not been promoted.

Beginner: A navigator who would not have competed before 01/09/08.

9. Entries close on Wednesday 3rd February, 2010. Entry fee €70 excludes competitors personal accident insurance and IRDS (€120 including competitors personal accident insurance and IRDS at standard rate). The CPA is €8 per person for any competitor aged 16 or 17. All drivers must have a valid 2010 Competition Licence and 2010 IRDS letter of acceptance. Maximum number of starters is 50. The 72 hour rule will apply, and only paid-up entries accepted.
