## REGULATIONS



### CLASSES:

The Rally will include the following classes:

- Class 1 Group N up to 1400cc
- Class 2 Group N 1401cc to 1600cc
- Class 3 Group N 1601cc to 2000cc
- Class 4 Group N over 2000cc
- Class 5 Group A up to 1400cc
- Class 6 Group A 1401cc to 1600cc
- Class 7 Group A 1601cc to 2000cc
- Class 8 Group A over 2000cc
- Class 9 Modified cars up to 1450cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated, not more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 9A Modified cars up to 1450cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated, more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 10 Modified cars 1451cc to 1650cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated, not more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 11 Modified cars 1451cc to 1650cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated, more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 12 Modified cars 1651cc to 2050cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated, not more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 13 Modified cars 1651cc to 2050cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated, more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 14 Modified cars 2051cc to 3500cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated or turbo charged, as per appendix "29". See note 2
- Class 15 Four wheel drive cars whose homologation has expired and other specified cars, as per appendix "29" See notes 3.4.5..
- Class 16 Historic cars. Cars in this class will compete over a reduced route and have a reduced entry fee.
- Class 17 Junior – Cars up to 1650cc, where the driver is under 27 years of age on the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year in which the event takes place. (Excluding Super 1600 and Kit Car Variant 1600)

**Note classes 16 and 17 will compete on stages 5,6,7.**

1. Pace Notes will be allowed on this event and competitors will be allowed to make Pace Notes on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> October between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm in accordance with the regulations.
2. Competitors making Pace Notes are obliged to register at Rally Headquarters, West Cork Hotel, Skibbereen between the hours of 8.00am and 12.00pm on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> October.

## INDEMNITY

### Indemnities, Declarations & Undertaking by Entrants, Drivers & Passengers.

(a) "I have read the Supplementary Regulations issued for this event and agree to be bound by them and by the General Competition Rules of the Royal Irish Automobile Club/Motorsport Ireland. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the Skibbereen and District Car Club, the Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd. t/a Motorsport Ireland, and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).
